Teams need to bring the following to the competition:

- Team Introduction Page (3 copies of a 1 page team overview to leave with the judges)
- Innovation Project
 - The Judging Session includes 5 minutes for students to present - be sure to bring the materials and props you need
- Robot Design
 - The Judging Session includes 5 minute for students' explanation of their robot design
 - There will not be competition tables or field kits in the judging rooms
 - A small printout of a the field mat will be in the judging rooms
 - Bring your Robot and any attachments
 - Consider bringing a printout of a program to share
- Core Values
 - The Judging Session concludes with a 3-minute reflection of Core Values
 - In the past, teams have been required to bring a poster explaining how their team embraces the Core Values. With the new judging format these posters are not required but teams are welcome to still do this as an activity to develop their team identity.
- General Reminders
 - Don't forget a laptop or device to program your robot and whatever chargers you need. Typically teams have time between their matches to make adjustments to their programs and a practice field is typically available in the pit areas.
 - Bring your team's Robot Game Rulebook (the red booklet that came with your team's kit).
 - A large tote or laundry basket in your pit area is great to collect your teams' jackets, hats and gloves.
 - Plan ahead for an easy lunch option for your team members. The schedule typically provides an hour break but be sure that everyone on your team takes a break for lunch.
