### **GETTING THERE**

The Ford Idaho Center is just north of the freeway off of the **Garrity Blvd Exit 38** west of Boise. It's about 20 minutes from the Boise (BOI) airport. There are two hotels (hot pink rectangles) across the parking lot: The Hampton Inn & Suites and the Home2Suites. Both are managed by the same company. Contact the hotel directly and tell them you are with the FIRST Idaho Regional to get the rates contracted by our Regional Director Lisa. The other local hotel is the MyPlace across the parking lot or there is another one south of freeway at the Holiday Inn Express. No price negotiations have been done with this hotel. Other hotels are available in Meridian off exits 44 and 46 and in Nampa off exits 39 and 40. These are listed on page 7 of this document. If you will be booking 10+ rooms per night you might ask for a discounted rate. Some hotels in this area do that for large groups.

**LOAD IN:** Load in will be from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Wednesday night and again from 7:45 a.m. – 9:00 a.m. Thursday morning. Only 5 members of your team at a time can be in the venue. **We are allowing Robot Weigh -in during load in to alleviate inspection time on Thursday morning.** The Loading Dock is on the east side of the Arena. Please be mindful of others and try to drop, unload and remove vehicles so that others can do so as well. There is a parking lot immediately adjacent to the load in area so save your smaller items for transport, by foot, from the lot to the venue rather than attempting to do it all in the loading lanes. **Please check in at the table just inside the venue. Look for the "Robots" feather signs.** 

TRAILER PARKING: The venue is kind enough to allow us a space near the loading dock to park trailers for the duration of the event. IT IS AT YOUR OWN RISK. THE FORD IDAHO CENTER IS NOT RESPONSIBLE SHOULD SOMETHING HAPPEN. You will need to have a locking hitch and all doors secured and locked. You must also park within the confines of the area outlined by biking racks or cones and tape.




<u>PITS:</u> Power will come from the floor or panel outlet behind your pit. You will need to bring necessary surge suppressors and extension cords for your pit. Pits are 10' x 10'. Please use Gaffer's tape, <u>not duct tape</u>, on floors/etc. Water and light snacks (chips, crackers, cookies, chocolate, granola bars) will be allowed in the Pits, but no outside food or drink will be allowed in the Arena stands. Tailgating and picnics are allowed on the grounds and parking lots. No outside food will be allowed inside the venue or under the overhangs at the doors. The pits snacks **must** be brought through the loading doors on Wednesday evening and Thursday morning and stored in your pit. Concessions will be open for coffee/breakfast and lunch on the upper parquet level of the arena. Boxed lunches by previous order will be offered this year. Keep an eye out for a menu with pricing and how to place your order soon. An email will be sent to your lead mentors on file in your team dashboard with FIRST.


